

#### Exam week runs January 22 to 30

On days that students have no exams, they are prohibited from accessing the school <u>unless</u> they have made arrangements with their teacher for assignment recovery or other purposes.

- Students must remain in the classroom until the exam dismissal time.
- All grade 9s will stay in their writing location until 10:30 am. At 10:30 am, all
  writers that are finished may leave- exam week expectations (off site unless
  requested to be at the school by a teacher for assignment recovery, etc.). If
  students are not leaving the building once dismissed, they are in the bleachers
  in the gym until pick up.
- No tech on their person during the exam (phones, tablets, air pods/headphones, smartwatches, etc.); no tech allowed until students leave the room.
- All personal materials except for what is allowed for the exam will be stored out
  of the room, or in their backpack which is left at the front/side wall of the
  classroom.
- Diploma exams all students writing 30-level diploma exams may use extra time if needed (up to double the posted time)
- School-based exams (gr. 9-11) posted times *include* extra time.

#### Gr 9 Provincial Achievment Test Result viewing

#### What are Provincial Achievement Tests (PATS)?

Provincial Achievement Tests (PATs) are administered annually to all Alberta students in grades 6 and 9. These standardized tests reflect the essentials that all Alberta students are expected to achieve, regardless of school choice or location.


In the fall, Alberta Education makes available copies of the Individual Student Profile (ISP) of each student to the staff of the school where the student wrote the provincial achievement test. Schools are responsible for forwarding ISPs to parents through the following options: forwarding the PDF ISPs electronically to parents though school systems, printing the ISPs for mailing, or signing up parents for myPass access to their child's account. Students and parents will be able to access the PAT Results ISPs as needed using myPass. \*ISPs for students who are excused or absent from the assessment, and students whose results have been withheld, will be annotated Not Available (N/A).

After registering your email address with Student Services, you will be able to view your student's Provincial Achievement Test Results.












#### **To view Current Grades and Teacher Comments**



#2 Once in PowerSchool please click on the tab "School Engage" located on the lefthand side of screen.



#3 Once in School Engage, under "Students". Now select the student you are making the change for.



#4 Once you've selected the student, you will see several different options on the righthand side of the screen (this may take a moment to populate). Next select "Change of Information Form" (+New) and complete this form.



To enter a change of address you will need to attach proof of address. Examples are utility bill or lease that includes legal parent or guardian name and new address.

#### **APPLY FOR A BUS PASS**

#1. Once in School Engage, click on "Student" and all students listed in your account will populate, select the student you are wanting a bus pass for.



#2. Once your options on the right side populate, find TRANSPORTATION and select "Bus Application"



#3. Complete all information on the form. When you come to the  $9^{th}$  tab make sure you click on the edulog to ensure that they are eligible for free bussing. It looks like this:

Once you submit, it can take up to 5 days for it to arrive at the school, until that time you are responsible for transportation for your student to/from school.









#### REPLACEMENT BUS PASS

#1. Once in School Engage, click on "Student" and all students listed in your account will populate, select the student you are wanting a replacement bus pass for.



#2. Once your options on the right side populate, find TRANSPORTATION and select Replacement Bus Pass Application, click directly on NEW



#3. Complete information requested on the form. If there have been NO changes to the address you will not need to check for eligibility.

Once you submit, it can take up to 5 days for it to arrive at the school, until that time you are responsible for driving your student to/from school. They are not permitted on the bus unless they physically have their card in hand to scan up entering the bus.
